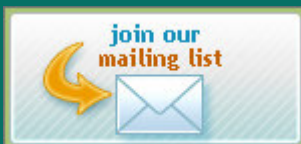

→ God's Word for Men

Joshua's appointment as a leader came after many years of faithfulness, both to the Lord and His commandments. He endured some horrific circumstances yet, throughout his life Joshua proved himself worthy of trust. Unfortunately many men today want to bypass the process of demonstrating faithfulness over a period of time. Their tendency is to desire instant relief from pain, instant recognition from work, instant prominence at employment, instant solutions for problems, and instant restitution when they repent for wronging others. God is not ignorant of your situation or your needs as a man. It takes time to learn to grow and be what God wants for your life. He takes His time in preparing His men for life and ministry. Consider the life of Joshua.

Examine the Scriptures:

- God takes His time preparing His men Ex 12:12; 17:8-16; 24:13; 33:7-11; Nu 13:1-14:38)
- God wants dependence and confidence (Deut 3:23-29; 31:1-8)
- God calls for your service today (Joshua 24:15)

spend in God's word. This is a sad state and must be changed if the local church is to change the world.

Get into God's word today and everyday. It will help you change your life and the lives of others!

As you look at your life and the life of the church where you fellowship, do you see yourself as a slave to sin or your circumstances? Perhaps you are struggling with conflicts or where God has put you in your work or marriage? Or perhaps you see yourself and your fellow believers wandering in the wilderness or conquering in the Promised Land? Throughout much of their circumstances the Jews were a complaining people, but in Canaan they were a conquering people. In the wilderness they kept looking back, but in the promise land they looked forward to conquering the enemy, claiming their rest, and enjoying their riches. The wilderness was an experience of delay, defeat, and death, but their Canaan experience was one of life, power, and victory. As you look at your spiritual map for your Christian life, where are you living?

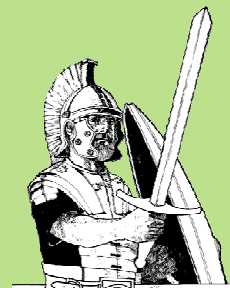
